Qualifications

Candidates should:

- (1) hold a doctorate (or be in the finishing stages of acquiring a doctorate), or possess an equivalent level of professional accomplishments;
- (2) be able to teach General Education English courses;
- (3) be able to lecture and conduct other types of classes on specialized subjects in English.
- (4) be able to perform key administrative and organizing tasks for our English program, including: course teaching assignment management; and helping to consolidate and expand our English curriculum;
- (5) demonstrate research achievements in the field of humanities and social sciences related to language, culture, society, history, and/or literature of the English-speaking world with an eye toward the effects/impact of globalization;
- (6) demonstrate interest in informatics research and willingness to conduct research in this field
- (7) demonstrate an ability to enthusiastically and actively participate in committee duties and other work related to the administration/management of the Faculty of Informatics;
- (8) demonstrate Japanese language ability (if Japanese is not the candidate's native language) sufficient for communicating with university staff and performing faculty duties competently.

Selection Method

• As a general rule, face-to-face interviews will be conducted primarily in Japanese for a select number of applicants who are judged to be qualified after review of documents. (note, candidates will not be reimbursed for travel expenses; also, depending on the COVID-19 situation at the time or other special circumstances, there is a possibility that interviews will be conducted online). On this occasion, each

candidate will be asked to give a presentation in Japanese explaining their research work and also to present a model Communication Skills lesson/lecture in English (Q+A following presentation will also involve questions in English and Japanese) based on our current syllabus for Communication Skills I, which is available for review at:

- (5) The names, institutional affiliations, and email addresses of two individuals who can provide professional references for the candidate.
