Open recruitment of Tenure-Track Associate Professor in Graduate School of Integrated Science and Technology, Shizuoka University

Job Title and Personnel: 1 Associate Professor on Tenure Track (Women Only)

Affiliation: Faculty of Science Engineering Area Business Development Management Series (Graduate School of Science and Technology, Department of Engineering, Business Development Management Course)

Specialization: Management of technology or risk communication (fields related to risk communication theory and practice, behavioral analysis based on social research, or strategic management)

Classes: Specialized subjects for graduate students (modern management theory, graduate school career design, data analysis and exercises, risk management theory), etc.

Employment, salary, and research support conditions :

(1) Term of office: 5 years from the date of adoption (See (2) below for the transition to tenure.) (2) Evaluation of tenure track faculty members: Evaluation of research achievements, leadership management skills, external funding acquisition results, research education and guidance skills for undergraduate and graduate students, etc. will be evaluated at the following times by reviewing documents submitted by tenure track faculty members, interim research reports, and research results at the end.

- ① The status of achievement of the research plan will be reviewed in the months after 1, 2, and 4 years after employment.
- (2) An interim evaluation will be made on the month following the date on which two years and six months have passed since employment.

③ Tenure screening is conducted in months not exceeding 4 years and 6 months after employment, and associate professors who pass the examination are hired as tenured professor.

The tenure here is not for life but retirement age (currently 65 years old).

(3) Salary: Annual salary system.

① Support allowances, managerial allowances, housing allowances, commuting allowances, special work allowances, overtime work allowances, and late-night work allowances shall be paid in accordance with the Shizuoka University Teacher's Salary Regulations.

2 Relocation travel expenses shall be paid separately in accordance with the regulations.

(4) Research support: In the first year, we will implement startup funds of 3.5 million yen per person and independent research space. In addition, research funds of 1.4 million yen will be implemented in the second year and 700,000 yen each in the third, fourth, and fifth years. (Amount is20 fiscal 2020 results)

① At least 70% of the efforts related to research activities during the term of office are made.

② After arriving, one of the professors of the Faculty of Engineering will support you as a mentor.

③ Research expenses are subject to change depending on the future budget.

(5) Business description: In addition to conducting research in the above specialized fields, he is in charge of experiments and practical training courses related to business development management courses, and provides research guidance or research guidance assistance to graduate students.

(6) Place of work: The place of work is Hamamatsu Campus (Johoku, Naka-ku, Hamamatsu City). Eligibility:

- 8 Be able to make a positive contribution to university management
- (2) [Incidental requirements: Satisfy two or more of the following conditions]
- ① Be a qualified Master of Business Administration (MBA) or Small and Medium sized Enterprise Management Consultant (SMEC)
- 2 Work experience in the business (non-academia) world
- 3 Experience in academic or social activities

 Use the JREC-IN Portal "Web Application Function". In this case, the "opinion of one person" described in (7) above will be submitted directly by e-mail from the recommender to the person submitting the inquiry.

Application deadline: August 16, 2021 (Electronic version until 17:00 JST on the same day)

When to leave: As early as possible after December 1, 2021

Selection method: After the document screening, interviews will be conducted for applicants who are judged to be eligible (travel and accommodation expenses required for the interview will be borne by them. In principle, face-to-face interviews are conducted, but remote interviews may be conducted in consideration of the applicant's circumstances, such as living abroad.) In the examination of research achievements, if there is a period of research suspension due to taking pre-baby, post-baby leave or childcare leave, it will be considered at the request of the applicant.
